Coach:

The Iowa Cubs are again providing the opportunity for high schools to play baseball games at Principal Park in Des Moines as part of the "High School Summer Series."

Here's how the program works:

■ You find an opponent that also wants to play at Principal Park, call or e-mail the Iowa Cubs with your date.

■ **Each** high school purchases **300** Iowa Cubs tickets at **\$4** each. (The players and boosters at your school can sell them to your fans, families and friends for whatever price you set. If you sell your tickets for \$5 each, your program makes \$300.) You may choose to purchase 300 tickets for a specific Iowa Cubs game (except July 4 or 5). Or you may purchase 300 ticket vouchers – good for any game (except July 4 or 5).

■ Each school must send in a \$600 deposit to secure their date. *The remaining \$600 must be paid at least five days before the day you play your game.* Total cost: \$1200. Teams will receive their tickets or vouchers once the \$600 deposit is received.

■ Your team plays in one of the top minor-league facilities in the country and also gets to enjoy Iowa Cubs baseball.

Each game will be seven innings, with each team taking a 10-minute infield prior to the game. There is a two-hour time limit for each game. In the event of rain, your game will be rescheduled as soon as possible.

The participating schools will be responsible for game balls and umpires. If you have someone interested in doing public address and working the scoreboard, they are welcome to do so. The Iowa Cubs will provide water and cups in the dugouts. If your team would like to shower after your game, arrangements will be made at the YMCA downtown.

Ticket information

Teams must purchase **300** Reserved Grandstand tickets at **\$4** each. (Those single-game tickets sell for \$10 each.) You may resell those tickets as a fund-raiser or give them to friends, family and sponsors — anyone.

Teams may purchase those 300 tickets for any one Iowa Cubs game (except July 4 or 5).

Or teams may purchase **300** ticket vouchers (at **\$4** each) good for any Iowa Cubs games (except July 4 or 5). These vouchers can be exchanged at the Iowa Cubs ticket window for a Reserved Grandstand ticket to any game, subject to availability. Teams and their fans don't have to use them all at once; they may be used all season once your deposit is received. (We are offering this option to give teams more flexibility in using their tickets.)

Note: If your team is playing a game after an Iowa Cubs game, a ticket to that game is needed to enter the stadium for the Iowa Cubs game. (Gates will open 90 minutes after Iowa Cubs game begins. No ticket is needed then.) If your team is playing before an Iowa Cubs game, a ticket to that game is needed.
